1. Who can apply?

business idea, but lack financial resources to implement the idea.

2. What kind of business ideas are supported?

We support diverse business ideas, but they must demonstrate:

- Feasibility and potential for success.
- A positive impact on the community.
- Long-term sustainability.

3. What support does CCSN provide?

We offer:

- Partial funding to help launch your business idea.
- Professional guidance and mentorship to improve your business management skills.
- Opportunities to network with other entrepreneurs and learn from their experiences.

4. How much funding is provided?

Funding amounts vary depending on the business idea and budget. Our focus is to provide partial funding while encouraging you to seek other resources for additional support.

5. What documents are required to apply?

You will need to submit:

- A clear description of your business idea.
- A detailed work plan outlining your steps and goals for implementing the idea.
